Call for Manuscripts *SRATE Journal*

The SRATE Journal is a peer-reviewed publication of the Southeastern Regional Association of Teacher Educators. The mission of the SRATE Journal is dissemination of scholarship and research related to the profession of teaching with an emphasis on teacher preparation. The journal is published twice yearly using thematic and non-thematic formats and indexed by ERIC. Volume 27(1), mirrors the fall 2017 SRATE and ATE annual conference theme and strands, **Educators in a Democracy: Preparing the Next Generation**. All manuscripts must be original, unpublished works and directly relate to the theme. Manuscripts not related to the theme will not be considered.

Journal Theme: Educators in a Democracy: Preparing the Next Generation

Preparing Educators as Agents of Democracy in a Global Society

- Strategies to equip teachers to prepare students to engage in global decision-making (economic and social justice and educational equity)
- High impact practices such as study abroad experiences, service learning, and civic engagement to develop teachers and leaders to serve as change agents within a global society

Restoring the Democratic Ideal in Educator Preparation

- Preparing teachers to be able to equip future generations to participate fully in society
- Strategies to restore the democratic ideals of education in a democratic society

Reclaiming Educator Preparation, Policy, and Practice

- Preparing teachers to meet the social and academic needs of diverse student populations
- Strategies in educator preparation that foster teacher voice, resistance, and resilience

Submission Requirements

Style

Authors should use the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association* (6th edition). All text pages should be numbered. Please do not include a running head.

Format

Length	manuscripts, including references, tables, charts, and figures should not exceed 15 pages.
Word-Processing	manuscripts must be submitted in Microsoft Word, Times New Roman font, 12-point text, double-spaced, with one-inch margins. Tables, charts, and figures should be placed at the end of the manuscript and follow APA formatting guidelines.
Cover Page	title of manuscript, date of submission, author's name, institutional affiliation and address, email address, statement that the manuscript is not under consideration nor has it been published, biographical information that identifies your title, your institutional affiliation and area(s) of research interest (30 words per author).
Abstract	concise 100-word, double-spaced narrative should be included at the beginning of the manuscript.
