

SRATE Journal Editor Position Open

The Southeastern Regional Association of Teacher Educators (SRATE) is seeking applicants for Editor of the SRATE Journal.

The SRATE Journal Editor is responsible for:

- *selecting themes
- *publicizing calls for manuscripts on the SRATE website, through the SRATE listserv, and via other appropriate venues
- *receiving and organizing manuscripts
- *sending manuscripts to reviewers
- *communicating with authors and reviewers
- *selecting manuscripts for publication
- *editing submissions for publication
- *sending the SRATE Journal to the webmaster of the SRATE website in a timely manner
- *recording, preparing, and reporting at the board meeting and business meeting held at the SRATE annual meeting in October
- *presenting a session at the annual SRATE conference (i.e., publishing in the SRATE journal) and ATE annual conference

The SRATE Journal Editor is responsible for providing her/his...

- *travel costs
 - *meal costs
 - *lodging
- (All SRATE board members are responsible for the above items.)

SRATE conference registration fee is waived for up to 3 editors.

The editor will serve as the SRATE representative to the ATE delegate assembly at the national meeting and receive the stipend of \$500.00 toward travel reimbursement.

The letter of application should convey your...

- *interest in and contributions to SRATE.
 - *abilities and experiences with note-taking, organization, and accountability.
 - *experience with editing, proofing, and coordinating of journal articles.
 - *understanding of the responsibilities as delineated above.
 - *support from your institution (letter by university dean/supervisor in support of editor).
- ...in serving as the SRATE Journal Editor.

Letters of application should be received electronically by **April 1, 2019** with a selection made no later than June 1, 2019. The position will commence following the publication of the spring/summer edition of the journal.
