Search for SRATE Journal Editor

Responsible for:

- *selecting themes;
- *publicizing calls for manuscripts;
- *receiving and organizing manuscripts;
- *sending manuscripts to reviewers;
- *communicating with authors and reviewers;
- *selecting manuscripts for publication;
- *editing submissions for publication;



SRATE Journal Editor is also responsible for:

- *sending information to webmaster;
- *recording, preparing, and reporting at board meetings and business meetings;
- *presenting at annual SRATE conference and at ATE annual conference;
- *serving as a delegate at ATE (stipend).



A letter of application should convey...

- *interest in and contributions to SRATE;
- *understanding of responsibilities listed on website;
- *support from your institution (letter by university dean/supervisor).

Letters of application must be received electronically by **April 1, 2016** with a selection made no later than **June 1, 2016**.

The position will commence following the publication of the spring/summer edition of the journal in 2016.
